TOUGH AND THRIFTY

The closer you look, the better we look... and the '75 Ford gives you more than ever to take a closer look at! In addition to the regular pickup, you should look into SuperCab pickups and new F-150 Heavy-Duty 1/2-tonners.

Choice of cabs. Regular Cab... the roomy 3-passenger pickup with full-width front seat and in-cab storage space behind the seat. SuperCab... the double-duty 2-door pickup that can seat a family of six. SuperCab provides 44 cu. ft. of in-cab cargo area behind the front seat, optional rear bench seat or jump seats. Crew Cab... the 4-door pickup that seats 6 big adults.

Choice of luxurious comfort. All Ford pickups—Regular Cab, SuperCab and Crew Cab—are spacious and comfortable with a seven-inch-thick full-foam front seat cushion standard. Ford pickups are available as value-packed Customs, distinctive Rangers and top-of-the-line Ranger XLT's. Whichever model you choose, a gleaming bright grille and front bumper are standard. Ford's exclusive Twin-I-Beam front suspension is also standard. It provides structural strength and smooth riding comfort.

Choice of engines. The thrifty 300-cu. in. Six is now standard in most series, and you have a wide choice of V-8's ranging from the 302—the smallest V-8 any pickup offers—up to 460 cubic inches (see page 15). All F-100 Series engines feature "breakerless" Solid State Ignition system—standard. And radial ply tires are available in most sizes across the Ford line.

Choice of 4 x 4's. Four-wheel drive is available on the F-100 and F-250. Key options include full-time four-wheel drive with SelectShift Cruise-O-Matic transmission. You get a strong, silent chain-drive type two-speed transfer case and constant 4 x 4 traction.

Choice of options. Ford offers a wide range of options to meet your needs. See pages 14 and 15.

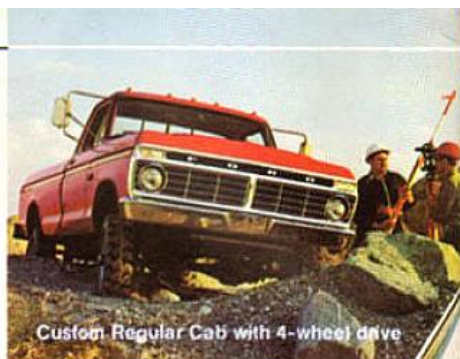
Choice of series and bodies. Ford light-duty trucks are offered in four series—F-100, F-150, F-250 and F-350—with GVW's up to 10,000 pounds. They are available in Styleside and Flareside pickups, Chassis-Cabs and Stakes. Complete cab and body availability by series and GVW's are shown on pages 10 and 11.

Recreation vehicles—like the 140-in. wb. Super Camper Special pickup—are shown on pages 12 and 13.

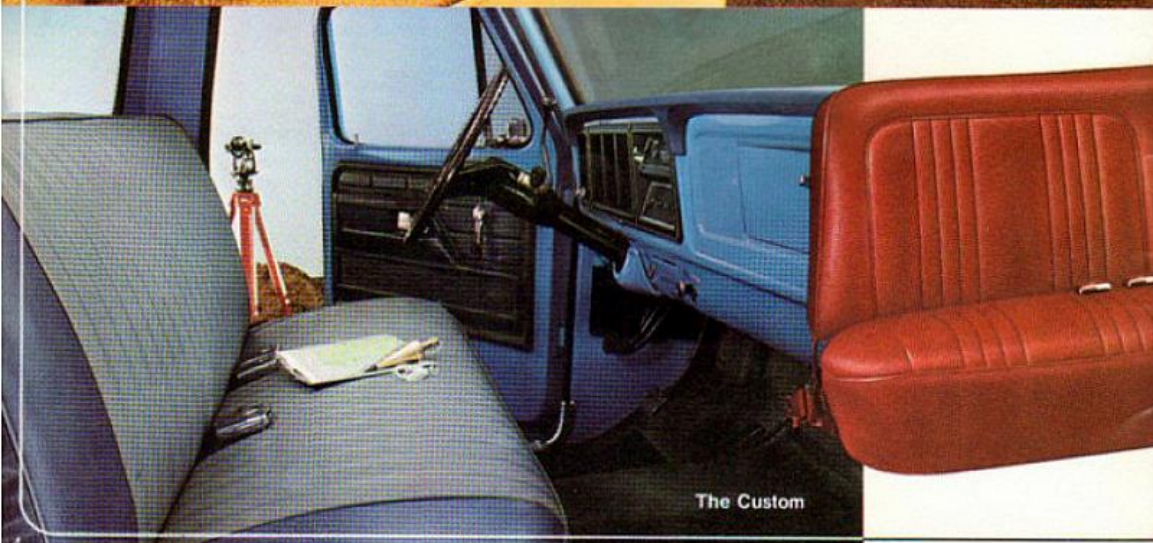

LONG-WEARING LUXURY

Ford Regular, SuperCab and Crew Cab pickup interiors provide spaciousness, comfort and quiet. On most models, the gas tank is mounted outside the cab between the frame rails. The result? The cab is quieter than ever and you gain room. The big, roomy Ford cabs also provide for storage behind the seat in Regular Cabs. The seat has five inches (four inches Crew Cab) of fore-or-aft front seat travel to accommodate tall or short drivers. The full-width seat holds three big adults with plenty of hip and shoulder room. And seven inches of soft, resilient foam in the seat cushion plus five inches in the seat back provide solid seating comfort. Seats are covered with attractive, long-wearing upholstery. Doors are finished with handsome molded panels with integral armrests. And Ford interiors are carefully color-coordinated with exterior paint colors. Roomy Ford cabs are extra quiet, too, because of special insulation designed to reduce noise.

Custom trim level is standard, and features deluxe fresh air heater/defroster (high-output heater with SuperCab) • energy-absorbing sun visors and instrument panel padding • instrument cluster with green backlighting • keyless locking doors • color-keyed molded door panels with integral armrests and paddle-type door handles • seat belts • windshield washers • two-speed windshield wipers • dome light with door courtesy light switches • ash tray • large glove compartment with push-button latch • sponge-grain headlining • black rubber floor mat • door scuff

plates • black, red, blue or green vinyl seat trim. Pickups have 10-inch day/night rearview mirror, LH and RH bright-metal exterior mirrors • taillights with integral stop, turn, backup lights and reflector • hub caps (except 4 x 4's without full-time drive).

Ranger interiors include (in addition to or in place of Custom features) color-keyed Super-soft vinyl seat upholstery in black, red (except SuperCab), blue, green or ginger • instrument panel molding with black accent • color-keyed door panels with bright moldings • shoulder-high vinyl bolster around rear area (SuperCab) • additional insulation • color-keyed perforated headlining (insulated) with bright molding • color-keyed wall-to-wall nylon carpeting • black steering wheel with simulated woodgrain insert • color-keyed sun visors • cigarette lighter • two courtesy lights (SuperCab). Exteriors feature bright moldings on windshield, rear window, rear quarter windows (SuperCab) and roof drip rails • bright wheel lip moldings • bright hub caps (except 4 x 4 option and dual-rear wheel units). Styleside pickups also include bright bodyside moldings with vinyl insert • bright tailgate moldings top and bottom and bright tail-light bezels. Ranger trim not available Crew Cab.

Ranger XLT interiors offer (in addition to or in place of Ranger items) deluxe color-keyed, long-wearing cloth and vinyl seat upholstery (Super-soft vinyl is a no-cost option) • color-keyed pleated padded upper door panels with simulated woodgrain accented moldings and map pocket lower panels • color-keyed wall-to-wall cut-pile nylon carpeting (including rear storage area) • bright instrument panel molding with simulated woodgrain insert • bright seat-pivot covers • additional insulation • convenience group (cargo, engine, glove compartment, ash tray and courtesy lights, glove compartment lock and inside 12-in. day/night mirror) • color-keyed vinyl headlining (with special insulation) and sun visors. Exteriors feature bright wheel covers (15" or 16.5" wheels except 4 x 4's). Styleside pickup includes upper tailgate applique panel and molding • aluminum tailgate applique panel.

New Custom Decor Group is available for Custom pickups (Regular and SuperCab). This option includes knitted vinyl seat trim in black, red, blue, green or ginger • color-keyed floor mats with insulation • bright moldings around windshield and rear window • bright drip rail moldings • bright hub caps (except F-100 4 x 4's).

COMFORT & CONVENIENCE

The closer you look, the better we look . . . just slip behind the wheel and look about. Observe all of the quality features and convenient controls. Work them and see how carefully everything is designed and positioned for your driving convenience. All controls are fully lighted, easy to see and use.

A modern, efficient blend-air type heater is standard (optional high-output heater is standard with SuperCab). This heater offers precise temperature control and excellent heat output mixed with fresh air as desired. Optional air conditioning is integrally designed and concealed behind the instrument panel. The compact air conditioner does not even reduce the size of the large glove compartment. You'll enjoy a smart looking interior with plenty of stretch-out spaciousness.

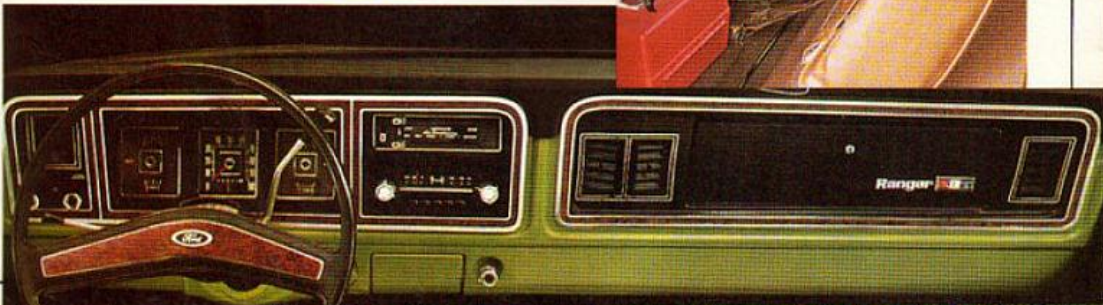
Observe the optional new *Low Fuel Economy Warning Light* on the instrument panel that signals you when low-engine vacuum is robbing your fuel. And on the steering wheel horn bar, notice the new *Speed Control* that allows you to effortlessly maintain a constant speed on those long trips. It's optional with 460-cu. in. V-8.

Color-keyed, molded door trim panels have integral armrests and convenient paddle-type door handles designed right in. *Window regulators* are low-effort car-type for easy, reliable operation.

Even on Regular Cabs, you'll find a large in-cab storage area. This handy area is the result of having the gas tank moved outside (on most models) leaving additional in-cab space. A storage area that's 5½-ft. wide, and can hold a variety of things like tool boxes, suitcases or golf bags within the lockable cab.

Outside, look over the door. You'll find a *drip molding*—standard on every Ford Pickup—designed to discourage those pesky window leaks that all-to-often occur on cabs without drip moldings. And try Ford's *one-hand tailgate latch*. See how easy it is to open and close the sturdy double-wall tailgate.

SUPERCAB VERSATILITY



Now you can have a two-door pickup that seats the whole family . . . even a family of six! Ford's family-duty SuperCab is spacious enough for a full-width back seat. SuperCab makes a big difference in interior carrying capacity, too, with 44 cu. ft. of cargo space behind the front seat. Camping gear or tools fit easily on the 5½-ft. wide by 2-ft. long rear floor.

If you want to carry both cargo and people, you have a choice of optional arrangements. You can pick Ford's exclusive full-width rear seat that folds down to provide a flat, steel floor for cargo. Or, Ford offers two facing jump seats that fold out of the way to clear the rear area for cargo. Ford jump seats have foam-padded seat backs as well as cushions.

The standard front seat with seven inches of foam padding provides room for three big adults. Seat back design allows easy access to the rear compartment from either side. Large 15 x 15-inch rear side windows are standard. Flip-open windows are optional.

SuperCabs come with 6¾ or 8-ft. Styleside pickup boxes or as chassis-cabs in F-100 through F-350 Series. GVW's range up to 9,300 lb. for heavy loads like slide-in or frame-mounted campers. Gross Combination Weights go up to 15,000 lb. for fifth-wheel trailers and 18,000 lb. for conventional trailers.

1. Foam-padded full-width rear seat (optional) folds flat for cargo with durable steel back to make load floor.

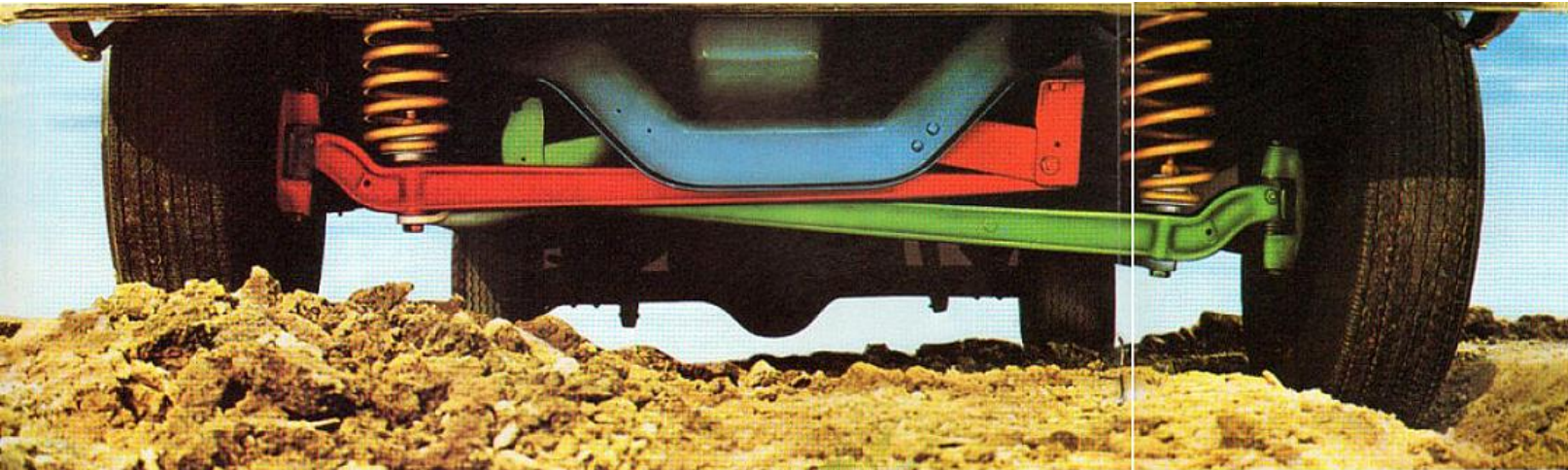


2. Jump seats (optional) have foam-padded cushion and back, fold out of the way quickly when not in use to clear the floor.

RUGGED & DURABLE

Famous Twin-I-Beam independent front suspension remains an exclusive Ford feature for both ruggedness and ride. Each front wheel has its own forged I-beam axle with big coil spring to step over bumps independently to cushion the ride. Twin-I-Beam suspension also contributes to good cornering, provides a solid, firm "command" feeling. No caster or camber adjustments are needed because this simple, sturdy suspension has caster and camber angles built in structurally and maintained by forged-steel I-beams. You get a smooth ride and responsive

handling—plus the strength and durability of two forged I-beam axles. Complementing the suspension system, Ford's long wheelbase also helps provide a smooth pickup ride. The wheelbase for Ford's most popular Styleside body is 133 inches long. A long wheelbase acts to space out the bumps and give the suspension system a better opportunity to absorb and dampen shocks . . . providing a solid, smooth ride.

The F-350 Super Camper Special and F-350 Styleside pickups both feature an 8-ft. box on 140-in. wheelbase. Their long wheelbase with regular 8-ft. box length puts a greater portion of the cargo box ahead of the rear axle, shortens the rear overhang and provides excellent load weight distribution with heavy camper bodies.

The F-100 and F-150 give you a comfortable ride in a tough pickup truck. In addition to the other Ford features already covered, these pickups have long and 2½-inch-wide rear leaf springs for easy going—especially when riding empty or with a light load. And soft-riding tires up to L78-15 in size are available—including HR78-15 steel-belted radials. Steel-belted radials hold the road, provide excellent cornering and braking on wet pavement.

The massive Ford hood has double-wall sections and bridgelike construction for both strength and stiffness. The inner and outer panels are welded into a single rigid hood unit that minimizes vibration or flutter. Sturdy galvanized front fender aprons, pickup box inner panels and double-wall door and tailgate construction are other examples of Ford's strong, durable construction.

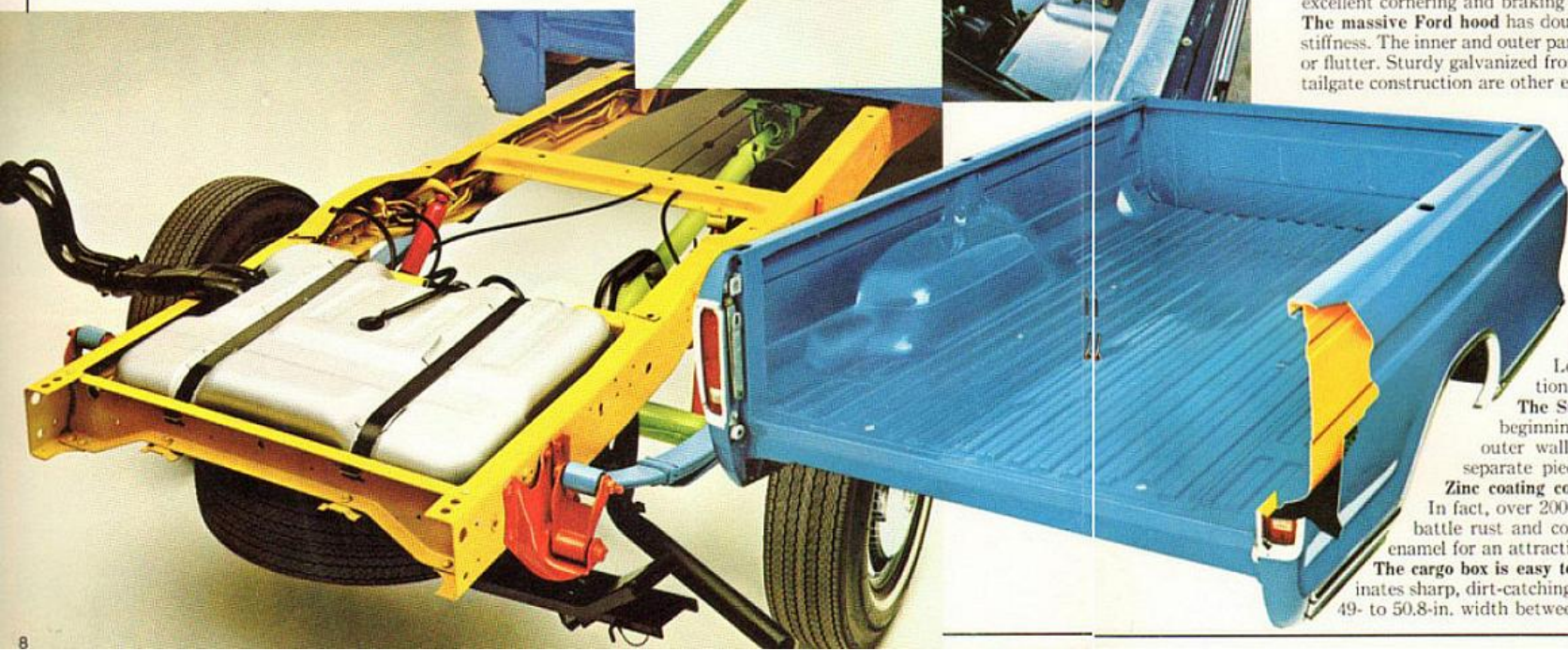
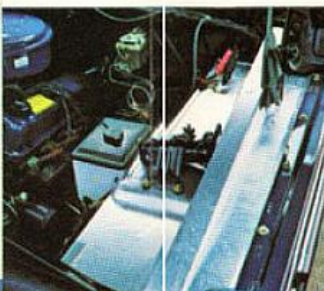
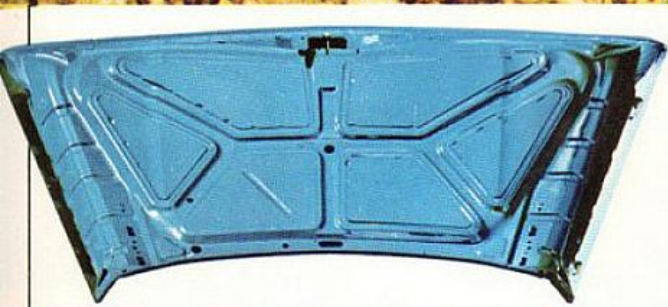
Wide-track stability gives Ford pickups a firm, steady stance and road holding ability. Tread width measures over 64 inches, and with front and rear tire tread widths practically equal (as illustrated at left), wheel tracking is even. Front and rear stabilizer bars are included in the Camper Special Package and are standard on the Ford Super Camper Special pickup for great resistance to roll.

Sturdy frames. F-100 through F-250 frames are extra wide from the cab on back providing a strong, stable foundation for the big Styleside pickup box. Sturdy frame siderails are up to 8-in. deep. On most models, the fuel tank is mounted within husky frame siderails under the pickup bed. **Long, wide progressive rear leaf springs** adjust to load conditions for a good ride—light or loaded. Leaf springs also provide control over lateral axle motion and absorption of driving and braking forces.

The Styleside body is built strong. Double-sidewall cargo box is only the beginning. Ford's design utilizes a single strong sheet of steel to form each outer wall. This construction eliminates the complex joining of the three separate pieces that it replaced, thereby reducing possible rust-prone joints.

Zinc coating covers the insides of the double sidewalls as well as the cargo side. In fact, over 200 sq. ft. of galvanized metal is used throughout Styleside pickups to battle rust and corrosion. Four-coat paint process includes two coats of high solids enamel for an attractive, hard gloss finish.

The cargo box is easy to clean, too. The pickup bed's curved wall-to-floor transition eliminates sharp, dirt-catching corners. You can quickly sweep or hose out the cargo box. The big 49- to 50.8-in. width between wheelhousings provides easy clearance for carrying paneling flat.

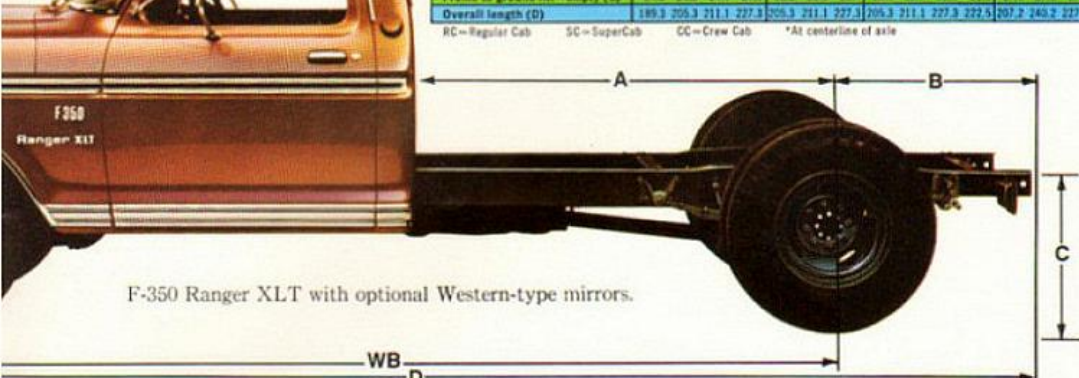


CAPACITY

Ford chassis-cabs are available with Regular Cab, SuperCab and Crew Cabs up to the big F-350 Series. Ford F-350 chassis-cabs combine large carrying capacity with Twin-I-Beam front suspension riding smoothly. Dual-rear tire models offer a maximum GVW rating of 10,000 lb. They are available for mounting van or other special-purpose bodies.

All sturdy Ford F-350 chassis-cab frames comply with the SAE 34-inch width standard in body areas to facilitate mounting of the body of your choice.

Regular Cabs offer 137- and 161-inch wheelbases (60- and 84-inch cab-to-rear-axle dimensions) to accommodate 9- to 12-foot bodies. Both of the 155-inch wheelbase SuperCab and Crew Cab chassis have CA's of 56 inches. Ford chassis-cowl models are also offered in the F-350 Series.

MINIMUM OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT REQUIRED WITH CAMPER SPECIAL

To provide optimum performance for camper applications, a V-8 engine and either a 4-speed or Cruise-O-Matic transmission are required. In addition, the following chart shows the GVW and minimum size tires needed for use with the Camper Special Package. This does not necessarily represent the maximum equipment obtainable and in many cases additional optional equipment is available for maximum Camper loads and applications. For example, the super cooling package is recommended for extended high temperature climate operation on F-250; 9.50 x 16.5D or E tires are recommended for optimum handling and stability for single rear wheel units with full-size campers.

The popular *Ford F-350 Super Camper Special* is a "Rec Vehicle" through and through with 140-in. wheelbase and offering high-capacity "Super Single" rear tires (including radials) for accommodating big slide-in campers up to 12 ft. long.
