The Scorpion cockpit is impeccably appointed with leather bucket seats, cut-pile carpeting and full instrumentation. A unique sliding roof panel lets in the sky, while underneath, Lancia's brilliant 70 year heritage is working. Scorpion reacts with responsive direct-action rack-and-pinion steering, four-wheel disc brakes for stopping power, and a taut four-wheel



independent suspension evolved from competition experience. Best of all, Scorpion carries the nameplate of a truly singular car and the pride of ownership that goes with it.

















## SPECIFICATIONS:

Body/Frame—Unitized construction, electrically welded. Reinforced longitudinal stress members. Rigid passenger compartment featuring controlled crushability of front and rear bodywork sections. Five coats of paint; phosphating coat; anti-rust coat (electrophoresis); primer coat; pigment undercoat; high-gloss enamel finishing coat. Wheelbase: 90.55". Front track: 55.59." Rear track: 57.32".

Engine—Mid-engine, transversely mounted and canted 20° to the rear. Twin overhead cam inline 4. Water cooled. Vertical dual barrel downdraft carburetor. Displacement: 1756 cc. (107.13 cu. in.). Compression ratio: 8.0 to 1. Bore and stroke; 84mm. x 79.2 mm. (3.31 x 3.12"). Exhaust emission control system.

Clutch—Single dry plate.

**Transmission**—Five speeds forward plus reverse. Fully synchromeshed in all forward gears. Console mounted stick shift.

**Gear Ratios**—1st: 3.75. 2nd: 2.235. 3rd: 1.522. 4th: 1.152. 5th: 0.925. Reverse: 3.071.

Differential Ratio -3.928.

**Drive**—Through the rear wheels by axle shafts connected to differential and to wheels through constant velocity ball joints.

Front Suspension—Independent. Struts incorporating shock absorbers, coil springs and rubber buffers. Stabilizer bar. Lifetime lubrication.

Rear Suspension—Independent. Struts incorporating shock absorbers, coil springs and rubber buffers. Stabilizer bar also acting as longitudinal reaction bar.

**Steering**—Direct acting rack and pinion. Steering linkage joints are lifetime lubricated. Turns in 34.28" diameter.

**Brakes**—Power assisted, disc brakes on all four wheels. Twin master cylinder. Mechanical parking brake.

Wheels and Tires—Light alloy disc wheels. Rim size: 5½ J x 13." 185/70 SR x 13 radial ply tires.

**Electrical**—12-volt system. 750-Watt Alternator. 45 Amp/hr. battery.

Instrumentation—Speedometer with trip recording odometer, electronic tachometer, battery charge warning light, fuel gauge with reserve indicator, oil pressure gauge with warning light, coolant temperature gauge with warning light, brake fluid low level and front friction pad wear warning lights, parking brake warning light, directional signals. Electronic clock. Windshield wiper switch, outer marker master light switch, panel light switch. Dual spray nozzle and synchronous wiper operation.

Ventilation and Heating System—Air intake on hood. Air outlets with flow-direction controls are mounted in dash and console. Hot water heater. Two speed heater fan. Warm air defrosting provided for windshield. Electric rear window defogger. Flow-through ventilation

Fuel Tank-15 gallons.
