UN-SQUARED OR SIMPLY, **SLEEK**

The distinctively streamlined shape should give you a hint. Go for a drive, and the 271-hp V-6, taut independent suspension and confident cornering fully reveal Crosstour's sporty nature.

A double wishbone front and multi-link rear suspension offer predictable handling and a smooth ride. The front shocks feature a specially designed rebound spring within the shock tube that enhances front tire contact with the road when cornering.

Even though the Crosstour has a high, commanding presence, its center of gravity is notably low. Honda engineers achieved this by placing the engine, transmission and fuel tank as low as possible in the chassis. The results can be felt in how well the Crosstour handles.



The Crosstour features a standard 271-hp V-6 engine with Variable Cylinder Management™ (VCM®). This technology can activate and deactivate cylinders as needed to provide brisk acceleration while maximizing fuel efficiency!

The Accord Crosstour can analyze the G-forces being exerted on the vehicle, and its transmission will hold a gear accordingly through a turn for enhanced performance.

The available Real Time 4WD system provides added confidence when the weather takes a turn. When traveling down practically any low-traction surface, the system can detect a loss of traction. It can then automatically send power to the rear wheels to help keep you on course and underway.

Sink down into wide, supportive seats and take command of a powerful 360-watt audio system. The EX-L model adds XM[®] Radio⁵ and a USB Audio Interface,⁶ not to mention Bluetooth[®] HandsFreeLink^{®7} which easily interfaces with your compatible mobile phone.

Shift into reverse in a navigation-equipped Crosstour, and the system's screen can also help give you a look at what's behind you.

On EX-L models, both front passengers enjoy heated seats, and the driver's seat features two-position memory.

Standard dual-zone climate control lets front passengers select their own temperature settings.

The Crosstour's removable, water-resistant under-floor storage box is perfect for keeping things out of sight.

Need to make more room? The 60/40 split rear seatback can be folded down from the rear doors or from the cargo area.

SAFETY IS OUR MISSION

At Honda, our safety engineering emphasizes systems to help protect you, as well as those that help you avoid collisions altogether. Making advanced safety features standard is more than a goal. It's a philosophy.

To help reduce the likelihood of whiplash injuries, the front seats have active head restraints. They move up and forward in a sufficient rear collision.

All five passengers benefit from 3-point seat belts. And the front seat belts are equipped with an automatic tensioning system that will tighten in a moderate-to-severe frontal impact.

Outboard rear seats have the LATCH (Lower Anchors and Tethers for CHILDREN) child-restraint system.

The Accord Crosstour has an Advanced Compatibility Engineering™ (ACE™) body structure. This Honda-exclusive design enhances occupant protection and crash compatibility in frontal collisions. By dispersing crash energy more evenly throughout the front of the vehicle, less force is transmitted to the passenger compartment.

The Crosstour's standard front, front side and side curtain airbags* can help reduce the likelihood of injuries in a collision. The side curtain airbags also feature a rollover sensor. The front passenger's side airbag uses the Occupant Position Detection System (OPDS) to help prevent deployment if a child or small-statured passenger is out of position and in the airbag's path of deployment.

Brake Assist, a component of the anti-lock braking system (ABS), helps apply full braking force in some emergency situations. Electronic Brake Distribution (EBD) helps balance braking forces depending upon dynamic loading.

The Crosstour's Tire Pressure Monitoring System† (TPMS) will notify the driver when air pressure is significantly low.

During oversteer or understeer, Vehicle Stability Assist™ (VSA®)‡ can brake individual wheels and/or reduce engine power to help restore your intended course.
