
The new Integra. True aerodynamic sophistication





The new Integra. From bumper to bumper, the sweeping aerodynamic lines of the Integra's body are as distinctive as they are graceful.

Up front the headlamps are fully retractable, blending in perfectly with the bonnet and helping to create an overall design that's exceptionally efficient. This efficiency is enhanced still further by the flush mounted windows and body panels minimising wind noise and maximising fuel consumption. Even the door handles have been inset into the bodywork and the twin door mirrors are shaped to ensure that the new Integra slices cleanly through the air.

The new Integra has the engineering capabilities to match its style.

Take the remarkable 1500cc engine for example. Producing a highly creditable 85bhp, it has 12 valves not eight, increasing power and improving fuel efficiency. Should you prefer automatic transmission you have the benefit of four speeds instead of the usual three – thanks to our own 'Hondamatic' transmission. The tailgate with its large glass area curving gently round at the sides, helps to create an interior that feels even more spacious than it is.




The driving experience starts here











As soon as you sit in the beautifully supportive seat you'll notice that all the controls fall easily to hand. Immediately in front of you is the wraparound dashboard affording you an excellent view of the road ahead as well as the instrumentation. All the major controls are located within fingertip reach on handy stalks on either side of the steering column. Down by the driver's seat there are remote releases for the tailgate and fuel flap. And for your listening pleasure, the Integra comes with a radio cassette unit as standard.



Efficient Heating and Ventilation.

Conveniently positioned in the centre of the dashboard are the controls for the highly efficient ventilation system. The infinitely variable heating control and 4-speed fan means that you've always got the ideal combination of warm and cool air. There are even heating ducts in the rear to keep back seat drivers comfortable as well.


Easy-to-Read instrumentation.

Right in the middle of the instrument panel are the large speedometer and tachometer, and at either side gauges for fuel contents and water temperature. All the instruments are clearly marked in white and are well lit making them easy to read at night as well as in bright sunlight. The panel also features a comprehensive display of warning lights to keep you fully informed at all times.

Handy Door Pockets.

To help keep everything neat and tidy yet always to hand, the Integra has deep storage pockets in both of the front doors.

Split Folding Rear Seats.

In the new Integra, the rear seats can be folded forward separately or together to allow virtually any combination of luggage or passengers to be carried. It's hard to believe that such an efficient shape could contain so much interior space. But when we designed the new Integra, we paid great attention to ensuring that the mechanical components took up the least amount of room, leaving extra head and legroom for the passengers.


The comfortable seating can accommodate five adults making long journeys more pleasurable. A glove box, coin tray and various storage pockets take care of all the odds and ends, whilst a spacious luggage compartment has plenty of room for suitcases.




Room at the back.

Lift up that wide opening tailgate and you've got no less than 10.3 cubic feet of luggage space. And that extremely generous capacity is almost doubled to 19 cubic feet when the rear seats are folded forward. The rear parcel shelf shields your luggage from prying eyes, or can be removed completely for when you've got an exceptionally large load.




Compact 12-valve engine.

A model of efficiency, the Integra's engine utilises a remarkable 3-valve per cylinder configuration that has been refined and developed from our Grand Prix racing experience. The crossflow head with one exhaust and two inlet valves for each cylinder ensures optimum combustion. This design also has the benefit of giving the compactness of a conventional unit with the sort of performance associated with 16 valve engines. From a capacity of 1488cc, it produces a powerful 85bhp at 6000rpm.

The engine's performance is improved even further by the lightweight, diecast aluminium cylinder block and by the specially designed intake and exhaust manifolds which optimise the 'exhaust pulse' effect.


Hondamatic. 4 speed fully automatic transmission with lockup torque convertor.


Offering four speeds instead of the usual 3, Hondamatic gives you all the advantages of a manual gearbox with the ease and simplicity of automatic transmission. The lock-up torque convertor transmits the engine's power directly to the wheels, ensuring ultra-smooth gear changes and outstanding fuel economy. The Hondamatic system also features an overdrive ratio in top for relaxed high speed cruising.

Performance with efficiency, reliability with progressive production techniques, durability with compact, lightweight design. All these features and more combine to ensure that the new Integra is a truly 'complete' design.

Suspension System.

The new Integra incorporates some very advanced technology into its suspension system to give an extremely smooth but responsive ride together with superb road holding characteristics.

Trailing-link Rear Suspension.

The trailing-link type beam rear suspension gives the Integra incredible high speed directional stability, road holding and a comfortable ride. The system also incorporates a special design where the brake backplate is connected to the trailing-link to make braking extremely stable as well as providing a good anti-lift effect in an emergency.

Front Ventilated Disc Brakes.

The Integra has ventilated discs on the front to dissipate the heat rapidly and so give assured, progressive braking everytime. Plenty of back-up is provided by self-adjusting drums on the rear.

Wide, Low-profile Tyres.

To complement the highly advanced suspension and to ensure the ultimate cornering abilities in all weathers, the Integra is fitted with wide 185/70SR13 radials.

Wheels.

To complement the new Integra's exceptional styling, smart alloy-style wheel trims are fitted as standard.



Complete anti-corrosion Protection.

Your new Integra will come fully protected against rust with a complete anti-corrosion treatment. All vulnerable areas are sealed with a top grade anti-rust wax. To give the rest of the bodywork the best possible protection, all the panels are made from electrolytic zinc coated steel and then thoroughly sprayed with electrostatic paint. Finally, the entire underfloor section is proctected from stones and gravel by a special chip-proof primer.







