














5 speed transmission.

Prelude is an exceptional car for a very selective group of motorists. It offers a combination of luxury, sportiness and economy that you won't find reproduced anywhere else.


### LUXURY IS THE STANDARD IN PRELUDE


The luxury you enjoy in your Prelude goes far beyond - rich upholstery fabrics, deep carpets. It includes a list of standard features that add up to superb comfort and pleasure.

For example there's an AM/FM stereo radio so you can enjoy the widest possible choice of radio listening wherever you go. There's a quartz powered digital clock. There's a door-panel map-pocket. The steering wheel is a handsome four-spoked design. The left-hand outside mirror is adjustable from inside with a touch of the convenient lever. And the trunk release is right beside you in your driving seat.

All of these touches in addition to the standard Honda luxuries which exist on every Honda – things such as: flow through ventilation which ensures fresh air even with the windows shut tight. And the vents at either end of the Prelude's dash allow airflow up and outwards to side windows as a protection against misting.



### SCULPTURED DESIGN THAT WORKS

Prelude is a functional car. The lines are sporty and graceful, of course. But the body shape is designed to carry out two vital functions. First, the streamlined contour of the car not only helps to ensure that Prelude slips through the air with the least possible drag and wind noise, it also gives the car extra stability at highway speeds. Second, the car is built as a trapezoid. It's widest at waist level, tapering neatly above and below the belt line. This shape gives the maximum usable interior space where it's necessary. The result is added room and comfort. And Prelude opens up a whole extra dimension of driving enjoyment, at the touch of a finger. Standard in every Prelude is a poweroperated sunroof which slides back to let you enjoy the pleasures of open-air driving, without sacrificing solidity or comfort of the hardtop design.

#### QUALITY! ENGINEERED IN

The Honda reputation rests primarily on the excellence of the engineering. Prelude is proof. This car is built around the soundest engineering available.

The body itself is a good example. It is the Honda monocoque design. The individual steel members are assembled and welded together in a solid, rigid shell which adds the strength of each piece to the overall strength of the car. This gives a combination of strength and lightness that pays off in performance and fuel economy.

The brakes couple self-adjusting front discs with rear drum style brakes in a power-assisted format that features diagonally linked dual circuits. This ensures that even if one circuit should be damaged you still have front and rear stopping power on opposite sides of the car.

The ride is smoother and quieter than you'd expect in cars of Prelude's sporty character. Road bumps are virtually ironed out. The standard transmission is a precise five-speed manual which gives an exciting feel, excellent control and a highway efficiency which adds to the legendary economy of your Honda powerplant. And of course, the optional transmission is the fully-automatic three-speed described earlier.

Even the finish of the Prelude is engineered. Where road salt and flying stones do their worst, at the lower, front and side panels, Prelude uses corrosion-resistant paint for added protection. Maybe you'll be attracted to Prelude by its appearance. But the deeper you look, the more you realise that the reasons for going Prelude are all based on superb engineering quality.

#### COMFORT AND MORE COMFORT

### KEEP YOUR EYE ON CONDITIONS


