
Luxurious Roomy Interior

Needle Roller Bearings Throughout Engine





POWERFUL


Did you ever see a modern racing car engine? If so, you'll recognize this Honda 606cc double overhead camshaft 57 horsepower engine with four synchronized carburettors as the ultimate in space age sophistication. Honda has mounted this superb powerplant in a compact fastback coupe, the most versatile of the new breed of automobiles. Yet this frisky little pup doesn't demand a racing driver or sports car maniac to drive it. It handles as gentle as a lamb and hugs the road even in tight corners like it was glued to a slot. Smooth, too, with independent four wheel suspension. There are none of the astronomical expenses required by a racer, either. A carburettor for each cylinder feeds just as much gasoline as

needed. Double oil filters, paper and centrifugal, keep the engine oil clean and hold down expenses. A single disc diaphragm clutch and positive floorshift give butter-smooth gear changes.
