Experience the fun of driving a car with aerodynamic body styling.


Feel how smoothly the Honda Coupe's synchromesh transmission takes you through the gears.
















We've pictured here just a few of the many deluxe features that come to you as standard equipment on the Honda Coupe.

Among them: An aircooled, four-stroke overhead cam engine. Fourspeed synchromesh transmission. Front-wheel drive. Radial ply tires. Selfadjusting power-assisted front disc brakes. Rack and pinion steering. Special mag style wheels. Front bucket seats with headrests. Flow-through ventilation. Sportstyle side mirror. 230° tachometer. Outside recessed door handles. Hinged rear side windows. Roof console. A rear seat that flips down for more storage space. And a rear window that flips up for easy access to that storage space.


