



YOU NEVER REALIZE HOW MUCH YOU TAKE VISIBILITY FOR GRANTED UNTIL IT'S GONE. Take pulling into a blind intersection. Walled in on both sides, you're forced to inch forward until you determine the path is clear. It's a hassle. But it's your only option. To help make these types of situations more convenient, the LX features an available Wide-view Front and Side Monitor.<sup>8</sup> At speeds below 7.5 mph, a camera on the grille can provide a view to the left and right while a camera positioned on the underside of the passenger side mirror can help provide greater visibility in narrow passes and while parking. When backing out of tight spaces, a separate system uses a camera to help provide a view to the rear. To some, three cameras may seem excessive. But when it comes to knowing what's around you, is there really such a thing?





A first in its class, it uses a front-mounted millimeter-wave radar sensor that is designed to detect an imminent collision and respond by preemptively retracting the front seatbelts and preparing Brake Assist<sup>12</sup> to help you stop faster as soon as you forcibly press the brakes. Should another vehicle rear-end you, active headrests<sup>11</sup> are also designed to instantly raise and shift forward, helping to reduce the likelihood and severity of whiplash.






