The Volkswagen Vanagon is a unique vehicle. It combines the handling and comfort of a car with the convenience and utility of a van.

When it comes to space, Vanagon doesn't cut corners. On the outside it's only about a foot longer than a Porsche 911, but on the inside there's space to carry just about anything.

Each wheel is independently suspended. It drives and handles

more like a car than a van or a bus. It offers the responsiveness of rack and pinion steering and the confidence of power-assisted front disc brakes.

Vanagon's 1.9 litre water-cooled gasoline engine with Digi-Jet fuel injection provides the acceleration and passing power you need.

Large, low-step front doors, a wide, easy-to-open sliding side door and huge liftgate at the rear are welcome conveniences.

For extra cargo space you can simply remove the middle bench by removing a few bolts and sliding the seat off its special track. Pack up friends and family and take to the open road. Vanagon seats seven people comfortably.

To add to the feeling of sedan style luxury, Volkswagen offers a special GL version of Vanagon. The Vanagon GL comes with rich velour upholstery. Each seat has its own folding armrest. Interior

panels are trimmed with cloth. There's tinted glass, a rear passenger courtesy light and a rear window wiper/washer. Vanagon GL's Premium AM/FM 4-speaker stereo cassette Sound System has electronic tuning, a seek/scan feature and digital time/frequency display. A special two-tone exterior paint finish is standard on Vanagon GL and metallic paint is available as an optional extra.

You'll be hard-pressed to decide if it's a sedan, bus, wagon or van. Actually, Vanagon combines the best of all four. But best of all, it's a Volkswagen.

A unique feature of the Vanagon Camper is the pop-top roof which gives you plenty of extra headroom and access to the upper double bed. The pop-top has a plexiglass

skylight with a removeable interior shade.

It's more than a unique motoring convenience. Vanagon Camper is a well-equipped, economical travelling companion.





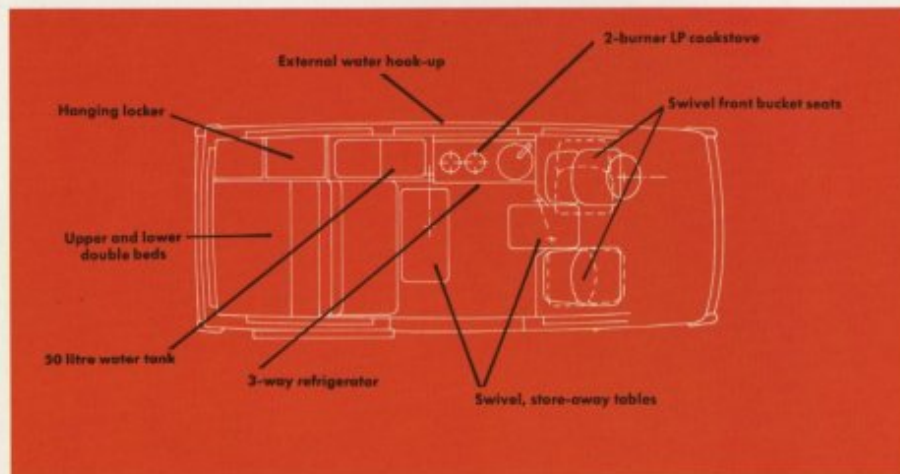
Meals on wheels and there's no check-out time.
