Inside a Jetta there seems to be something for everyone. For the sun worshipers and amateur astronomers there's the optional multi-position sunroof. With the 12-way programmable seat, people of all sizes can find their own favorite position behind the wheel (and if you can't pick only one perfect position that's ok, your seat can remember your 3 favorite settings). And for those who feel 16 cubic feet of trunk capacity is limiting, the split-rear folding seat provides the extra cargo space you need. Fold down 40, 60, or 100% of the backseat to fit the occasional drum kit, hockey stick, stack of lumber, mannequin, or surfboard. And if an adaptive rear seat doesn't convince you the Jetta has something for everyone, maybe the abundance of cup holders will. That's right, cup holders for everybody, even those sitting in the foldable backseat.

200 Turbo charged horses to satisfy that keen sense of adventure you're 25% more likely to have. Compact, powerful, and all that more aggressive because of it. Call it the Napoleon complex, but this lightweight engine can't resist proving itself at every opportunity. With 200 turbo powered horses at its disposal, the 2.0T does just that, but with significantly reduced turbo lag. Leveraging its direct fuel injection, this bundle of power gives you all the pull you need, at both ends of the power band. Oh, and it does all of this as a 4-cylinder, so you get the power of a larger displacement engine in an engine that knows how to suck every last sip of acceleration out of a gallon of gas. Fuel efficient and powerful? It's like they can read your mind.

A balance of power and performance. There's nothing tame hidden inside the 20-valve heart of the standard Jetta engine. Every cubic centimeter of this 2.5L powerhouse exudes performance. And if you're a motor enthusiast interested in innovative design, take a close look at the cylinders' heads, because they trace their design heritage directly to those found on the Lamborghini Gallardo V10. Not too shabby a place to pick up some inspiration.

The optional DSG® gearbox is a feat of engineering that marries the ease of an automatic (transmission) with the thrill and control of a manual transmission...well, a manual transmission that allows you to shift between gears in a matter of hundredths of a second. You see, with the DSG gearbox, when you shift up or down through the gears there's never a pause in power. That's because the next gear is already applied but not yet "active" until you shift; making a trip up and down the gears fluid and virtually instantaneous. We don't have exact numbers on this, but it's a safe bet that DSG can make anyone who enjoys driving a lot more likely to smile.

Race cars have them, exotic sports cars have them, and according to recent studies, so do many Jetta owners. They're little paddles mounted to the sides of the steering wheel, and they give the driver the option of tapping through the gears without removing his hands from the wheel. \*Only available on the GLI equipped with DSG.

Every Jetta with an automatic transmission comes with Tiptronic®. With Tiptronic, you can fully take advantage of the 6-speed automatic. And Tiptronic offers a very appealing optional feature, you can either drive in "regular" mode, sport mode, or you can opt to select your own gears and drive it like a manual. Although the effects of Tiptronic on Jetta owners have not been thoroughly studied, we've got a hunch that Tiptronic increases not only driving performance, but pinball scores as well.

VW owners are 84% more likely to smile. It's a fact. But there's something unique to the smile curvature of the GLI owner. Perhaps it's a side-effect of the 200 hp turbo-charged 2.0 Engine. Or the Autobahn-proven sport handling. Some have suggested that the subtle sound of the turbo charger whirring to life underneath the hood permanently affects the pleasure receptors in a GLI owner's brain. And when that sound is coupled with a hint of aluminum on the dash, and a generous amount of leather right where the driver will most enjoy it, on the three-spoked steering wheel and shift lever; there's little reason for one's smile to not obtain a mischievous look about it. Especially when the road ahead is empty.

VW owners are 14% more likely to be very happy with life as it is. Which is probably why they choose to own a car designed to protect one thing, the lives of those inside. The Jetta performance in this test earned the praise of IIHS (Insurance Institute of Highway Safety) president, Dr. Adrian Lund. He called the Jetta, "An exemplary performer." He's not the type to laud praise like that willy-nilly. You have to do something impressive, like become the first car to earn a perfect score in their demanding side-impact testing.<sup>1</sup>

**Optimized front head restraints.** Help minimize whiplash injuries from rear-end collisions.

**LATCH.** Lower Anchors and Tethers for Children. A standardized child-safety seat system.

**Side Curtain Protection<sup>®</sup>** Airbags deploy down the roofline from the A-pillar to the C-pillar to help reduce head and upper torso injury in the event of side impact.

**Automatic locking feature.** Locks automatically engage at 8mph. And unlock automatically should the airbags deploy.

The brakes of the Jetta are loaded with technology designed to help protect both the people in the car and those in front of it. And that's not just to impress those VW Owners who are 32% more likely to belong to a human rights organization.

Of the many insights discovered while probing the mind of the Jetta owner was the fact that VW owners are 37% more likely to keep up with developments in technology. Like ABS (Anti-lock Braking System), optional ESP (Electronic Stabilization Program) with EDL (Electronic Differential Lock), EBA (Engine Braking Assist), ASR (Anti-Slip Regulation Traction Control), HBA (Hydraulic Brake Assist), EDL (Electronic Differential Lock) and EBD (Electronic Brake Pressure Distribution).

Unlike most other sedans, the Jetta has an electro-mechanical power assisted steering system, which besides improving handling, it helps the environment by eliminating the need for hydraulic fluid. That should impress those of you 30% more likely to recycle.

## Jetta Lights

The GLI's High Intensity Gas-discharge Xenon headlamps. State-of-the-art headlamps with scratch and chip resistant polycarbonate lenses aren't worth much if they're misaligned. That's why these optional headlamps automatically level themselves, adjusting their aim to help keep precise beams of light focused where a Jetta owner needs it, on the road ahead. Or perhaps they added that nifty auto-leveling feature because VW owners are 31% more likely to love buying new gadgets. But that might be a stretch.




